Resolved, By the Common Council of The City of Milwaukee, that the proper City officers are authorized and directed to issue a City check in the amounts as shown in the attachment to this file, payable to the City Treasurer or taxpayer as applicable, to be refunded to the taxpayers where appropriate, plus interest at the rate applicable pursuant to s. 70.511(2)(b), Wis. Stats., for an appeal that was filed as shown in this file, from date of payment to date of repayment; the amounts to be charged to the **2021** Remission of Taxes Fund, 0001 Org 9990 Program 0001 Sub-class S163 Account 006300 and the check to be delivered to the Customer Services Unit of the Treasurer's Office for disbursement; and, be it

Further Resolved, that the proper City officers are authorized and directed to reflect the reduction in State Tax Credits as shown in the attachment to this file by means of journal entries, charging the **2021** Remission of Taxes Fund, 0001 Org 9990 Program 0001 Sub-class S163 Account 006300, and crediting the State Tax Credit Fund; and, be it

Further Resolved, That delinquent interest and penalties on any account covered by this resolution are canceled.
