ALD. JOHNSON AND COGGS

An ordinance relating to remote participation in meetings of governmental bodies. 320-8 cr

This ordinance provides that any member of a city governmental body, as defined in state law, may attend, participate and vote in a meeting of that body remotely using any technology that makes it possible for the member to be seen and heard by those attending and observing the meeting. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 320-8 of the code is created to read:

320-8. Attendance, Participation and Voting Remotely by Member of Governmental Body. Any member of a city governmental body, as defined in s. 19.82(1), Wis. Stats., may attend, participate and vote in a meeting of that body remotely using any technology that makes it possible for the member to be seen and heard by those attending and observing the meeting.
