Resolution approving construction of nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City construction cost estimated to be \$310,000 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$410,000.

This resolution directs the installation and construction of certain public improvements which have been determined to be nonassessable by the Commissioner of Public Works. The City cost of the projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$310,000. The total estimated cost of these projects is \$410,000.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct nonassessable improvements; and

Whereas, Plans, specifications and cost estimates have been prepared for the following described improvements:

W. Hampton Ave. - N. Teutonia Ave. to N. 60th St. (WT410220004) File Number 220618: Hydrant alterations (Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 5010 -- 0. Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$235,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$255,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2022 construction season.

4th Aldermanic District

Alley Betw. W. McKinley Av.(ext'd), W. Vliet St., N. 20th St., N. 21st St. (new alley for DCD) (ST214220101) File Number 211748: Construct new alley, install permeable pavers. (Developer Deposit fund - \$75,000) The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$155,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2022-2023 construction season.
