Substitute resolution relative to acceptance and funding of 2023-24 ReCAST grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Substitute resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept, and fund the 2023-24 segment of the 2021-26 Resiliency in Communities After Stress and Trauma (ReCAST) grant from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services in the amount of \$1,000,000 with a City share of \$0 and a grantor share of \$1,000,000. The funding will provide evidence-based violence prevention and community youth engagement programs to assist high-risk youth and families and promote resilience and equity.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services to evidence-based violence prevention and community youth engagement programs; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant program from September 30, 2023 to September 29, 2024 will cost \$1,000,000 comprised of \$1,000,000, or 100%, grantor share and \$0, or 0%, City share; now, therefore, be it:

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it

Further Resolved, that the Commissioner of Health or their designee is authorized to execute the grant agreement for these funds; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant parent account of the 2023 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects Fund, the following amounts for the project titled ReCAST 2023-24:

2. Create the necessary Special Revenue Fund Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project Levels; budget to these Project/Grant values the amounts required under the grant agreement; and be it
