Resolution approving construction of nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City construction cost estimated to be \$840,000 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$960,000.

This resolution directs the installation and construction of certain public improvements which have been determined to be nonassessable by the Commissioner of Public Works. The City cost of the projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$840,000. The total estimated cost of these projects is \$960,000.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct nonassessable improvements; and

Whereas, Plans, specifications and cost estimates have been prepared for the following described improvements:

6th Aldermanic District

N. 5th St. - N. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr. to W. Keefe Ave. (WT410210606) File Number 191657: Relaying water main and lead replacement of service. (Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 5010 -- \$0. Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$590,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$610,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.

Various Districts:

Movable Bridge Upgrades (BR100230105) (File 221269): Movable bridge mechanical, hydraulic, and electrical upgrades (City Share Non-Assessable Structure Fund - \$250,000 additional Funds). The total estimated cost for this project is \$350,000. The engineering is anticipated to be completed during 2023.
