### ALD. PUENTE

Resolution authorizing the installation of a new traffic control signal at the intersection of West Bradley Road and North Granville Road in the 9<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic District.

This resolution authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to install a new traffic control signal at the intersection of West Bradley Road and North Granville Road with funding from the Department of Public Works capital fund at an estimated cost of \$90,000.

Whereas, The traffic volumes at the intersection of West Bradley Road and North Granville Road exceed federal warrants in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) for the installation of a traffic control signal; and

Whereas, The installation of a traffic control signal at the intersection of West Bradley Road and North Granville Road will provide for a better exchange of right-of-way over the existing all-way stop control resulting in a reduction in traffic congestion; and

Whereas, The estimated cost of the installation of a traffic control signal is \$90,000, and is included in the Department of Public Works traffic signal capital fund approved under Common Council File Number 100966; and

Whereas, The installation of a traffic control signal at West Bradley Road and North Granville Road is scheduled for summer 2011; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the Commissioner of Public Works is authorized to install a new traffic control signal at the intersection of West Bradley Road and North Granville Road with funding from the Department of Public Works capital fund.
